Dear friends & family,

Since our last newsletter, it has not been quiet at the WEC office. In September we had almost weekly conversations with people who were interested in going out with WEC. There was also a short orientation for a couple who started working at Cornerstone. And in October there was a Trek orientation for no less than 6 people, for those who go out with WEC for less than 2 years. At the beginning of November, we had a prayer day of WEC. Some missionaries on furlough shared about their work and so we could pray for it together.



On November 14th, at the WEC meeting at Cornerstone, Harriët and Alvaro Yanez were elected as our new 'Branch leaders' for a period of 4 years. They hope to take over the leadership from the interim leaders from January 1st. After a period of almost 1.5 years without branch leaders, we hope that stability and peace can now return to our team and to the whole of WEC Netherlands.

Alpha Emmeloord

Until a few years ago, the Alpha course was organised every spring by our congregation, in cooperation with a number of other churches. This has come to a standstill for a number of

years, partly due to the merger. Now we have picked it up again. We will start January 22nd. We now have 10 participants and hope for at least 20. We are grateful for the fine core group and people that have already agreed to cooperate. Pray for more participants and helpers. We also pray that even more people from our own church will sign up.

From September this year, the training

for my new role as the WEC Intern-tional MK Consultant (IMKC) began. This means that in WEC I am responsible for the care of the mission



kids. I will advise those who send people out into WEC from their support branches. Worldwide, there are about 1900 active WEC missionaries working in +/- 90 countries and from 80 different countries. Most support branches have someone who is responsible for the care of the children. I will be in regular contact with them to exchange resources and experiences that can help us in the care of our mission kids. As of January 1st, I will take over the role of IMKC from Steve and Gill Bryant, who have done this for 21 years (!). Pray for the handover and the formation of a steering group that can help me in this new task.

I am also still active in the care of missionaries in the Netherlands. On November 11th, we had a meeting for TCK consultants of different mission
